PHCHF recognizes that the strength of its membership is reflected in the many cultures and identities represented within its co-ops. PHCHF encourages applications from these diverse communities.



Our Goal

The purpose of the PHCHF Diversity Scholarship is to recognize people living in co ops who are actively promoting diversity through work within their community. We want to help them with their post-secondary education by providing them with award money, credit counseling and employment services.

The Scholarships

You could be eligible for a scholarship if you are going to a publicly funded Canadian college, university or approved apprenticeship-training program. We offer scholarships to students who are just graduating from high school, or are currently enrolled in post-secondary education, or are returning to school after a break to complete an undergraduate program.

We have special scholarships that are awarded to people who have shown exceptional leadership in their school and community, or who have taken an active role in mentoring young people, or have demonstrated a commitment to social justice.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- live in a PHCHF member co-op
- plan to attend a publicly funded, Canadian community college or university or approved apprentice training program on a full-time basis in the 2019/2020 academic year
- have used their knowledge and understanding of diversity to make a positive contribution to their school and/or local community
- have a demonstrated financial need
