

## Strategic Planning Pilot to Prepare for the End of Mortgage – Complete!

As part of a strategic planning program, Peel Halton, Central Ontario, and CHF Canada federations collaborated to assist four housing co-ops in planning for their long-term success. The pilot project aimed to promote strong governance, effective fiscal management, and sound leadership among the participating co-ops.









The pilot project included four housing co-operatives in different stages of End of Mortgage (EOM) planning. Three of the participating housing co-operatives were from Peel/Halton CHF, while one was from Central Ontario CHF.

As part of the pilot project, each of the participating housing co-operatives created a new logo for use in the communication, marketing, branding, and identity of their co-op. Creating and selecting various elements of the new logo proved to be a very unifying experience, and the attendees took great pride in seeing their creations completed.

Next steps: The four pilot co-ops have started to work on their End of Mortgage plans.
